- Pizzeria Uno on Ohio Street: Established in 1943, it lays claim to being the inventor of deep-dish (though Lou Malnati's may beg to differ) that stands head and shoulders above the rest.
- Lou Malnati's on Wells Street: Where's the butter? In this extra flaky crust, of course. What's more, a special blend of lean sausage covers the entire circumference of the pie for deliciousness in every bite.
